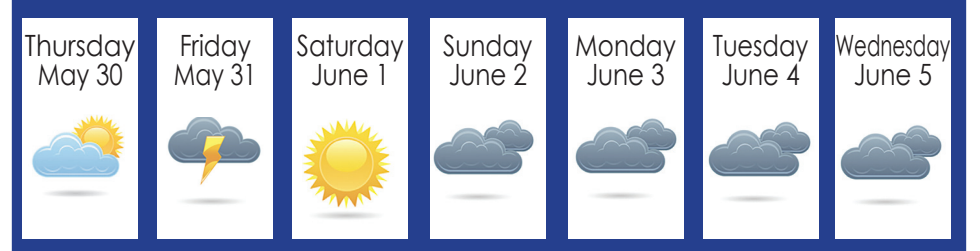

The Week Ahead:
Warmer and drier weather is the trend over the next week. High temperatures will finally push above average, with a stretch of highs in the 80s likely.

A few leftover showers Thursday morning will quickly clear out behind a passing cold

front. This will keep highs on Thursday cool, but cloud cover will clear throughout the day.

Friday will warm up a few degrees, but a stray thunderstorm may pass through in the evening. Thereafter is when the warmup really gets underway. Partly to mostly sunny skies each day with low chances for rain will aid in temperatures reaching the 80s consistently each afternoon.

Thursday: Partly sunny. Windy. Highs in the mid 60s.

Friday: Mostly cloudy. Chance for a shower or thunderstorm late. Highs in the upper 60s.

Saturday: Mostly sunny. Highs in the mid 70s.

Sunday: Mostly

cloudy. Highs in the low 80s.

Long Term: After many weeks of cooler and wetter weather then average, odds favor drier and warmer temperatures as we work through June.

While warmer and drier does mean that there will be less rain overall then we have received over the past six weeks, occasional passing thunderstorms will still provide rainfall from time to time. Hopefully, they are timely rain for crops.
