available that meets those unique needs and then connecting people with those different events,” Sanders said.

Any number of aging difficulties and hypotheticals can be thrown onto the instance of “Billy” and the Aging in Community program has an answer. If “Billy” is homebound by a chronic disease or physical disability, there are specialists that the program can connect him to. If he lives with dementia or Alzheimer’s, they can get “Billy” or his family in touch with a professional to program an Amazon Alexa device to provide him regular reminders to eat or drink water.

“Through our partnerships with Vocational Vision Rehab, the state hearing specialist, we’ve got adaptive equipment partners, lots of ways to overcome barriers that

are preventing people from seeking those social encounters. It’s not just about fundamentally having these events, it’s about also using it as a gateway to help people explore,” Sanders said.

As Sanders showed, it’s not just about playing “Wheel of Fortune” to get people out of the house, it’s about showing the rural and urban communities in the state just how many resources are available to them without breaking the bank.
