Fame Announces
2025 Inductees

MANDAN, ND-- The
North Dakota Music
Hall of Fame proudly
announces its 2025 Class
of Inductees, honoring
four influential artists
with deep ties to North
Dakota’s rich musical
legacy. This year’s in-
ductees are: The Blend-
ers – Beloved vocal
harmony group with
roots in Fargo, Richard
Torrance – Acclaimed
singer-songwriter
and guitarist, Skitch
Henderson – Legend-
ary bandleader and
founding conductor
of the New York Pops,
and Chuck Suchy –
Renowned folk artist
and musical ambas-
sador of the prairie

These exceptional
musicians will be hon-
ored during a special
Induction Ceremony on
Sunday, September 28,
2025, at Dykshoorn Park
in Mandan, North Da-
kota. The event is part
of the Dakota Music
Crawl, a daylong cele-
bration that includes
live music perfor-
mances, a music crawl
through local venues,
and a catered dinner.

A limited number
of tickets are now
available to the pub-
lic at Eventbrite.com
by searching “Da-
kota Music Crawl.”
This is expected to
be a sold-out event.
“This year’s class

showcases the extraor-
dinary range of talent
with North Dakota
roots,” said Marlo
Anderson, President of
the North Dakota Music
Hall of Fame. “From
nationally recognized
performers to cultural
icons, each of these
inductees—The Blend-
ers, Richard Torrance,
Skitch Henderson, and
Chuck Suchy—has
made a lasting impact
on the world of music.
We’re proud to cele-
brate their contribu-
tions and ensure their
legacies are honored
right here at home.”

The North Dakota
Music Hall of Fame
continues to build mo-
mentum as a statewide
movement, celebrating
the voices and stories
of musicians who have
shaped the cultural
fabric of North Dako-

Downtown
Mandan
disrupted by
power outage

Many people in Man-
dan rely on the internet
not only to connect to
the world around them,
but also to keep up with
important information
and handle business
transactions. This
makes any disruption
in the grid a significant
concern. As if to prove
this point, a temporary
delay in Mandan was
enough to greatly incon-
venience many of the
city’s workers, putting
a freeze on their daily
operations.

According to repre-
sentatives from Midco
and the company’s
website, the outage took
place on Wednesday, Au-
gust 27th, and was first
reported at roughly 8:00
a.m. While an exact an-
swer could not be given,
Midco staff claim that it
could have been caused
by construction workers
hitting a line in the area
of the Lonesome Dove

bar.

Regardless of the
cause, this temporary
outage resulted in at
least 60 nearby custom-
ers in Mandan losing
power- and even if it was
cleared up at around
3:00 on the same day,
the damage it dealt to
city operations was
more than noticeable.
Several local offices,
including the Morton
County News Journal,
were left without stable
connections, and some
businesses that de-
clined to be interviewed
were even forced to
close early when they
were unable to process
payments or access the
internet.

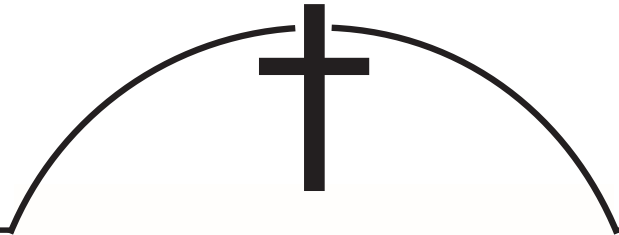
