Wednesday, July 23, 2025**

The Regular Meeting of the Beulah School Board was called to order by Chairperson Moore at 6:00 p.m. in the District Conference Room. Present at the meeting were Directors: Hatzenbuhler, McGraw, Moore, Schmidt, Seibel and Ziman. Absent: Director Reich. Also present were Superintendent Blackhurst; Business Manager Richau;

Chairperson Moore opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Director Hatzenbuhler motioned to accept the agenda. Director Schmidt seconded. Roll call with unanimous “aye” vote. Motion carried.
