WASHBURN PUBLIC SCHOOL INITIAL RESOLUTION FOR GENERAL OBLIGATION BUILDING BOND FUNDS

WASHBURN PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 4 MCLEAN AND OLIVER COUNTIES, NORTH DAKOTA INITIAL RESOLUTION FOR GENERAL OBLIGATION BUILDING FUND BONDS

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board (the "Board"), that it is necessary and expedient for Washburn Public School District No. 4, McLean and Oliver Counties, North Dakota (the "School District"), to issue its General Obligation Building Fund Bonds (the "Bonds") as hereafter described:

1. The maximum amount of the Bonds proposed to be issued is \$777,350.

2. The purpose for which the bonds are proposed to be issued is to provide funds to construct an addition to the existing facility, to make improvements to school property, and to otherwise improve and renovate school property and make site improvements to school property.

3. The assessed valuation of all taxable property in the School District, as defined in Section 21-03-01, N.D.C.C., is \$160,749,811 as last finally equalized for the year 2024.

4. The total amount of bonded indebtedness of the School District, all issued for school building purposes, is \$9,355,530.

5. The School District intends to issue the \$777,350 general obligation building fund bond resulting in a millage of 2.99 mills, equal to \$2.99 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation for the first taxable year after bond is issued.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the principal of, premium, if any, and

interest to be paid on the Bonds shall be paid from that portion of the tax levies authorized by Section 57-15-16, N.D.C.C. (School Building Fund Levy), as necessary for such payments, and, in the event the Bonds are issued, the tax levies authorized by Section 57-15-16 shall be dedicated to the repayment of principal of, premium if any, and interest on the Bonds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any owner of taxable property within the School District may, within 60 days after publication of this Resolution, file with the Business Manager a written protest against the issuance of the Bonds, describing the property which is the subject of the protest. If the Board finds such protests to have been signed by the owners of taxable property having an assessed valuation equal to five percent (5%) or more of the assessed valuation of all taxable property within the School District, as theretofore last finally equalized, all further proceedings under this Resolution are barred.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Business Manager is hereby authorized and directed to cause this Resolution to be published in the official newspaper of the School District, and that the Business Manager is further authorized and directed to post this Resolution on the website of the School District during the 60-day protest period.

quality, their cooling effects help mitigate extreme weather by reducing heat buildup and managing stormwater runoff.

Yunker, who has 12 years of experience in the horticultural industry, said this year she developed a bare-root tree planting and watering guide to accompany each tree given away to help ensure recipients have the knowledge they need for successful growth.

“Unlike container-grown trees, bare-root trees establish more quickly and adapt to their new environment with less transplant shock,” she explained. “I often tell people, ‘The first year, they sleep. The second year, they creep. The third year, they leap!’ This gradual growth process allows the roots to settle fully before the tree begins to thrive, leading to stronger, healthier long-term development.”

The giveaway operates on a first-come, first-serve basis for those interested in participating. The school receives priority in selection so the community may not have access to all three species during the giveaway, Yunker explained.

“I hope this giveaway will positively impact the community in ways I mentioned earlier, helping to enhance our local environment and strengthen connections among residents.”
