Preview of Agenda: Future Planning, Survey, Resignation, Superintendent Evaluation were added under New Business and Board Appointments was moved to the last item under New Business.

Abby Borchardt made a motion to approve the consent agenda that included August 18, 2025, Regular Board Meeting Minutes, Bills, Business Manager Report, Budget & Finance Committee Minutes, Destruction of Records Request, Annual Financial Report 24-25 for Approval, Annual Financial Report for Publication 24-25 for Approval, Final Certificate of Levy 25-26 for Approval, 25-26 Budget, and DPI Compliance Reports. Dawn Kruk seconded the motion. Motion was unanimously carried.

Administrators' Reports: Daren Christianson's report was re-

viewed by the Board. Topics of discussion included Staffing, Fund Levies, Bond Vote, Building Priorities, and English Learners. He added that there is still a need for one full-time paraprofessional at the High School.

Ethen Askvig's report was reviewed by the Board. Topics of discussion included Staffing Issues, Homecoming Week, MISO3, Summer School Enrollment, Phone/Device Policy, Cardinal Time, 10-Absence Policy, and Parent-Teacher Conferences. Athletic Director update was reviewed by the Board with Jr. High Volleyball Request, and Athletic Program Sponsorship and Music Integration as topics.

Jacy Bata's report was reviewed by the Board. Topics of discussion included Celebrations & Highlights, Academic Updates, Student Life & Activities, Operations & Policy, and Upcoming Events. She added that Friday was Grandparent Day and bake sale and discussed NDCEL Scholarship.

Old Business: The 2025-2026 budget was reviewed by the Board with updates and amendments made from the previously approved budget. Abby Borchardt made a motion to approve the amended 2025-2026 budget as presented. Dawn Kruk seconded the motion. Motion unanimously carried. Daren Christianson reviewed possible school wide efficiencies with the



Ethen Askvig reviewed game day broadcasting advertisement options with a company that would have licensed family friendly music available and create the ads for each game. Daren Christianson reviewed grants the District receives annually, grants recently applied for and a recent homeland security grant that was denied.

New Business: Dawn Kruk and Dave Hart reviewed Budget & Finance Committee topics that had not been reviewed during the meeting already including a mill levy increase vote in the spring and a priority list of needs with approximate costs. School Board convention is October 9th-10th in Bismarck. Abby Borchardt discussed with the Board a possible survey for the community regarding the needs of the District with building repairs and updates. Dawn Kruk will get the Superintendent evaluation to the Board members to have completed prior to the October Board meeting. Dave Hart read Tyler Feist's resignation to the Board. Dave Hart read Kyle Rollness's letter of interest and stated that Justin Cheatley spoke with him personally, both interested in being appointed to the School Board. He reviewed with the Board the people in the community he personally contacted to be on the School Board. Abby Borchardt and Daren Bachman also had community members interested but declined. Dawn Kruk made a motion to appoint Justin Cheatley to the open rural position and Kyle Rollness to the open at-large position on the School Board. Abby Borchardt seconded the motion.
