The police report for March was reviewed. The question was asked of Officer Krizan about abandoned vehicles and what the city can do to sell them so they do not need to be stored by the city. Officer Krizan stated he would look into the matter and report back as to what the process is.

There was no court report from March.

The City Engineer's report was reviewed. McCutchan stated that the report for the North side sewer televising was complete and a

report will be brought in May for council to review. Also stated in Gerving's report is that the Summit Avenue project will take place this summer.

Supervisor Chad Stern discussed with council the upcoming Spring Cleanup Week. Spring Clean-up will take place in May from Monday the 12th through Saturday the 17th. Stern stated that he and Auditor McCutchan will be driving around the city to find violations. This list of properties will be given to City Attorney Solem to write the violation letters. Discussion was held concerning the stock pile of broken concrete at the landfill. Stern stated that he would like to put an ad in the paper for concrete give-away, that anyone interested can haul it out of the landfill at no cost to them.

The WRT contract was discussed and Attorney Solem stated that he had not had the opportunity to contact WRT to discuss franchise fees and would do so soon and get back

The Hebron app maintained by Kat & Company was discussed as the contract has cost of maintaining the app is an annual payment of \$750. A motion was made to approve the contract renewal. Tibor/ Slinkard

Auditor McCutchan presented council with a beer and liquor license transfer for the annual April Showers event. A motion was made to approve the transfer. Slinkard/Dittus MCU. A request was made by Supervisor Stern for his wages to be reviewed. Auditor McCutchan stated that she had spoken to another Auditor and had found that Hebron is far below what other cities pay for the Supervisor position and one with the experience that Supervisor Stern possesses. A motion was made to approve an hourly wage of \$37.44. Tibor/Slinkard MCU.

Movie starring Alex Baldwin (Rust) will be shown at theatre this week

The movie "Rust" will be shown at the Mayer Theatre in Hebron this Friday, Saturday and Sunday at 7:30 p.m. each evening.

Rust is an American Western film written and directed by Joel Souza and stars Alec Baldwin (who also produced co-wrote the story with Souza), Patrick Scott McDermott, Josh Hopkins, Frances Fisher and Travis Fimmel.

The film gained notoriety for a shooting incident in 2021, where cinematographer Halyna Hutchins was accidentally killed when a live round was discharged from a prop revolver Baldwin was using.

The movie premiered at the Polish film festival Camerimage November 20, 2024, and is scheduled for a theatrical release May 2, 2025.

In 1880s Kansas, elderly outlaw Harland Rust comes out of hiding to rescue his 13-yearold nephew Lucas Hollister, after he is sentenced to hang for an accidental killing. Now fugitives, the pair have to outrun the vicious bounty hunter Fenton "Preacher" Lang.
