Introduction

The Grant County Courthouse, located at 106 2nd Ave NE Carson, North Dakota, is seeking proposals from qualified contractors to provide window repair and replacement services for the courthouse building. The scope of work includes one (1) immediate repair project and two (2) broader maintenance and replacement projects.

Scope of Work

The contractor may bid on one or more of the following items. Bidders are encouraged to provide pricing for each individual task as well as a combined cost proposal.

- 1. Broken Window Replacement
 - •Replace one (1) broken window on the 2nd floor of the courthouse.
 - •Work must include removal of broken materials, installation of a new window unit matching the existing style, and clean-up of all debris.
- 2. Window Reglazing, Resealing, and Winterization
 - •Inspect all courthouse windows.
 - •Reglaze, reseal, and re-winterize all existing windows to ensure energy efficiency, safety, and proper weatherproofing.
 - •Materials used must meet or exceed current energy code standards.
- 3. Full Exterior Window Replacement
 - •Remove and replace all exterior windows (around 130) on the court house that have not been replaced in the last 10 years.
 - •Replacement windows must maintain the character of the building while providing improved energy efficiency.
 - •Contractor must provide product specifications, warranties, and installation details.

The Grant County Courthouse, located in 106 2nd Ave NE Carson, North Dakota, is seeking proposals from qualified contractors to provide services for the flashing and sealing of the courthouse roof. This project is being undertaken to preserve the integrity of the building, prevent water infiltration, and extend the life of the roof system.

Scope of Work

The successful contractor will be responsible for the following:

- 1. Inspection and Preparation
 - •Conduct a full inspection of the existing courthouse roof.
 - •Identify and document any areas of deterioration or concern.
 - •Prepare surfaces for flashing and sealing.
- 2. Flashing
 - •Remove damaged or deteriorated flashing materials.
