

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council NOTICE IS HEKEBY GIVEN that the CLIV Council of Grafton, North Dakota will meet on August 21, 2025, beginning at 5:30 p.m. in the Grafton City Hall, 5 East 4th Street, Grafton, North Dakota, for the purpose of holding a public hearing on a proposal that the City issue revenue bonds under the Municipal Industrial Development Act of 1955, Chapter 40-57, N.D.C.C., in order to finance the project described below.

The Project consists of the construction and equipping of an indoor athletic training facility to include an indoor ice rink and walking track and site improvements to be located at 654 W. 15th Street, Grafton, North Dakota (the "Project"). The Project will be owned and operated by Grafton Blue Line Club, Inc., a North Dakota nonprofit corporation. The amount of the proposed bond issue is not to exceed \$7,000,000.

The bonds shall be limited obligations of the City payable solely from the revenue payable by Graf-ton Blue Line Club, Inc. and pledged to the pay-ment thereof. No holder of any such bond shall ever have the right to compel any exercise of the taxing power of the City to pay the bonds, or the interest thereon, nor to enforce payment against any property of the City.

Grafton Blue Line Club, Inc. is engaged in promoting and providing funding to support youth organizations, specifically youth hockey, and to enhance a public skating facility, and competitors are hereby notified of that fact pursuant to Chapter 40-57, N.D.C.C.
