Emulsion spill reported
in Mountrail County

BISMARCK, N.D. — Hess Corporation notified the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality of an emul- sion spill from a pipeline line it op- erates in Mountrail County on Sept. 12, 2025.

The incident occurred about 4 miles north- west of Stanley. The cause of the spill is under in- vestigation. Emul- sion is a mixture of crude oil and produced water flowing from the well head.

Hess reported the spill on Sept. 13, estimating 20,000 barrels (840,000 gal- lons) of emulsion released. The sub- stance surfaced and flowed approximate- ly 250 yards over agricultural land. No water resources have been impacted at this time.

Personnel from Environmental Quality are inspect- ing the site and will continue to monitor the investigation and remediation efforts.

North Dakota Department of Commerce
Relaunches Innovate ND Program
to Support Entrepreneurs

B I S M A R C K , N.D. —The North Da- kota Department of Commerce has re- launched Innovate ND, a voucher-based reimbursement pro- gram that provides up to \$50,000 to help entrepreneurs vali- date their business ideas and accelerate growth.

The program is divided into two six-month phases, each offering up to \$25,000 in reim- bursements. Partici- pants must complete both phases within 12 months.

“Innovate ND is more than funding — it’s a launchpad for scalable, high- impact businesses that can diversify and strengthen North Da- kota’s economy,” said Commerce Economic Development and Fi- nance Manager Carla Valentine. “We’re ex- cited to support en- trepreneurs who are ready to validate their ideas and bring inno- vation to the state.”

Program goals include:

- Strengthening the state’s entrepreneurial ecosystem and economic diversity.
- Educating partici- pants on lean start- up principles and customer identifica- tion.
- Supporting product and market valida- tion through mea- surable outcomes.
- Fostering scalable, innovative business- es with potential for primary sector cer- tification.

Eligibility highlights:

- The business must be based and headquartered in North Dakota, with at least one founder re- siding in the state.
- It must be in good standing with the North Dakota Sec- retary of State.
- Retail, hospitality and local service- based ventures are not eligible.
- Applicants must demonstrate a founding team, a defined problem, a unique value propo- sition, early custom- er validation, a pro- totype or roadmap, a go-to-market strat- egy, a revenue mod- el and a 12-month business plan.
