# Commission Proceedings

Regular Meeting August 20, 2025

Chairman Zenker called the August 20, 2025, meet-ing of the Grant County Commissioners to order at 9:08 a.m. All present honored our nation by reciting the Pledge of Allegiance. Public present: Riley Dahl, Grant County News.

Commissioner Hochhalter moved to approve agenda, seconded by Meyer. All present voting aye; agenda approved.

Moved by Meyer and seconded by Hochhalter to approve August 6, 2025 Regular Board of Commissioner meeting minutes. All present voting aye. Minutes approved.

Treasurer's report was reviewed

Old business: Reviewed from Raymond Christenson which was addressed to Governor Kelly Armstrong.

New business:

Hochhalter moved to approve bills totaling \$61,021.13. Seconded by Meyer. Roll call vote - Hochhalter - aye, Meyer

A hearing on the zoning change will need to be scheduled for the public to offer testi-

Meyer moved approval to pay for 960 yards of dirt at \$4.00 per yard to Don Staiger. Motion seconded by Hochhalter. Roll call vote – Meyer-aye, Hochhalter – aye, Zenkér – aye. Motion carried.

Motion made by Hochhalter and seconded by Meyer to pay balance of royalties to Kermit Certified yardage was 26,549 cubic yards at a price of \$2.00 per cubic yard. A deposit of \$20,000 had been paid in 2024, for a balance due of Roll call vote -\$33.098.00. Meyer-aye, Hochhalter – aye, Zenker - aye. Motion carried.

Application for approach submitted by Steven Schmid. Jon Alt recommended culverts be installed for both approaches. Because the road is not a main county road, culverts will not be supplied unless the county is to install them and build the approaches with a work order at the expense of the property owner. The property owner may build the approaches at their own expense. Meyer moved to approve application for approaches, seconded by Hochhalter. Roll call vote – Meyer-aye, Hochhalter – ave. Zenker - aye. Motion carried.

The 2026 budget expenses were discussed. Salaried employees, with the exception of Deputies Moore and Palmer, were approved for a three percent increase in annual pay. Hourly employees were approved for a one dollar per hour increase in pay, with the following exceptions: David Reineke will receive an increase of \$3.50, and Bert Harsche, an increase of \$2.50 to account for equity for years of service. Leroy Harsche will receive \$2.00 per hour pay increase for equity with similar operators pay.

Motion made Hochhalter and seconded by Zenker to eliminate one unfilled sheriff department deputy position for the 2026 budget year. The office will consist of the sheriff, three deputies, and one office assistant. Hochhalter stated if an acceptable deputy candidate is found, an addition of a deputy position may be considered. Roll call vote – Meyernay, Hochhalter - aye, Zenker – aye. Motion carried.

Moved by Hochhalter and seconded by Meyer to appropriate \$17,500 to Grant County Fair Association for 2026 fair expenses. Roll call vote - Meyeraye, Hochhalter – aye, Zenker aye. Motion carried.

Motion made by Hochhalter and seconded to levy 18 mills for road and bridge in all unorganized townships. Minimum mill levy of eighteen mills is required by 2025 legislation for counties and organized townships to qualify for Flex Fund distributions. The county will make an adjustment to the general fund levy to lessen the impact on taxes levied on all property in the county. Roll call vote – Meyer-aye, Hochhalter – aye, Zenker – aye. Motion car-

Being no further business, Zenker adjourned meeting at 12:53 p.m. FYI: next scheduled meetings will be September 3<sup>rd</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Budget hearing is scheduled for September 10th in the Courtroom of the Grant County Courthouse at 9:00 a.m.
