ifier, emphasized how important the team and coaches are to his experience.

“This is one of the most friendly sports I’ve ever been in,” Booke said. “Nathan is our funniest coach and makes me

smile every single time. That makes me want to come back every year. For me, it’s all about having fun and making progress.”

Riley Koval echoed the team spirit and excitement, calling archery a “very fun sport.”

“I’m excited to go to nationals for the second

time. Everybody in this sport is great,” said Koval.

Beyond the competition, Retzer emphasized the program’s core values — personal growth, inclusion and building community.

“I started coaching 12 years ago thinking I’d just try it for a year. Now, I can’t imagine life with-

out archery. We’ve grown from 20 kids to about 85 this year,” she said. “It’s a sport for everyone. We have kids with ADHD, kids who might not be able to play other sports—here, they find something they can do and succeed at.”

While medals are always a welcome reward,

Retzer said the biggest goal is to give the students a meaningful and memorable experience.

“I tell them, ‘I don’t care if you ever bring a medal home. I just want you to have fun,’ because if they enjoy it, they’ll keep coming back,” Retzer said.

The team will hold an end-of-season celebra-

tion at Hughes Shelter this weekend, handing out achievement medallions, state pins and coach choice awards.

After that all focus turns to Louisville — where they’ll not only shoot for their personal bests but also create memories to last a lifetime.
