Daycare receives grant for garden project

Cando Community Child Care applied and were selected to receive the North Dakota Farm to Early Care and Education Garden Grant. There were 241 applications submitted for the grant with 35 garden projects around the state being selected. The projects needed to be food related (not flowers).

This funding is made possible by the USDA Patrick Leahy Farm to School Program Grant through the North Dakota Department of Agri-

culture, as well as the Maternal and Child Health Program through North Dakota Health and Human Services.

As a recipient of this grant, Cando Community Child Care received \$400 to purchase items to enhance our center's learning opportunities. Thursday, May 22nd we took a field trip to the Cando Greenhouse to pick out plants, seeds, and soil. They picked out cucumbers, peppers, tomatoes, strawberries, zucchinis, and broccoli plants just to name a few. They also picked out seeds: radishes, carrots, beets,

beans, and peas. We also have purchased pots, two small hydroponic systems, and two root viewer systems. The root viewer systems are a clear container which allows the children to view the roots as the plant grows. The plan is to use one in our preschool classroom. The other we will use with the residents at Towner County Living Center. These will allow the children to grow herbs and vegetables this winter. This will be something both the children and residents will enjoy doing together!

Scholarship fund created in honor of Terry Belzer

Terry Belzer was an innovator, talented inventor and risk taker with an unlimited community-minded generosity to share his knowledge and talents. He was always on the quest to improve production agricul-ture. His last effort involved a desire to find a solution to the head scab problem in wheat. His innumerable hours leading this project resulted in voluntary contributions of \$100,000 dedicated to scab research. In addition, through his leadership, the 1995 legislature appropriated another \$350,000 to this effort. He was the first to begin growing irrigated pota-toes in Towner County.

Terry had long been involved with soil conservation through his no-till system of crop production and was one of the original members of the Manitoba-North Dakota Zero Till Farmers Association. He has shared his knowledge of No-Till with every-one. He was on the Zero-Till Board of Directors and was actively in-volved in many local, regional, and estate organizations.

The Towner County Crop Im-provement Association began a scholarship fund in Terry's memory.



The scholarship will fund a student enrolled in an accredited college as a junior, senior, or graduate student in any area of study, OR a 2nd year student enrolled in an accredited 2-year state, community, or technical college pursuing a degree in agriculture.
