and neighbors with somebody who is that type of person. So we're super excited for the different things that we'll be bringing to the community this summer and can't wait to see what happens," Cassie says.

The larger space allows for more seating and other opportunities.

"Having the larger kitchen is such a blessing. With the building came the vent hood and the ventilation system. ... But just having that vent hood is a big game-changer, because we did not have that in our last location. That's going to really open up our menu," Cassie says.

That expanded menu will include the Fossil Fuel pizza menu Roehl had developed at his business in Hettinger.

"Richard has been dreaming about wanting to do pizza for at least a year now. And as soon as Richard said the P word, Andy was like, 'I got you. Let me tell you about this brick oven pizza.' And so, yeah, we're very excited," Cassie says.



The oven is expected to arrive soon and Feel Good Coffee hopes to launch a pizza menu this month.

"We're going to start with the Fossil Fuel menu, just because we know that and have heard so many people just absolutely loved Andy's pizza, so we're going to start with those popular ones there. We're going to see what's popular here in our community and then we're going to do a rebranding at that time and we'll put the Feel Good Coffee vibe on those pizzas," Cassie says.

The business will definitely have chicken alfredo pizza and one of the Fossil Fuel favorites, a jalapeno popper pizza.

The business will also be adding a larger griddle and deep fryer, then expanding the breakfast and lunch menu.

"So, the breakfast menu will be expanding and then we'll definitely be adding different things to the lunch menu. I can see us probably doing some burgers and fries. There's been a lot of requests for that and who knows, anything could happen after that," Cassie says. The business will also continue its catering services.

Feel Good Coffee will have a pizza menu at the McKenzie Mercantile and will deliver to the bar as well.

The mobile trailer has been converted into a soda shack called Feel Good Sodas and parked at the swimming pool in the summer.

Hours will be 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday and 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. Saturdays. Those hours will expand into the evening by the end of March once pizza is added. The business has four employees, including three high school students.

"The community's been amazing. They've supported us the entire way through, and we are so incredibly grateful for them, and they are super excited to have some more dinner options," Cassie says.

"It is honestly beyond my wildest dreams. And I give it all back to the community. They have been a huge support for us. The kids have been amazing. We try to do whatever we can to help support the school, and I feel like that has really helped us grow as well. Then the catering opportunities have been huge. We've had a lot of opportunities to cater with different companies in towns such as Slope Electric Cooperative. They're a big one for us. I feel like that got our name out there a lot. I just feel very, very blessed and honestly it's been very surreal. I feel like it's taken this entire time for it to sink in that it even is real," Cassie says.
