

Dollars for Scholars accepting scholarship applications

North Dakota Dollars for Scholars is accepting scholarship applications from North Dakota high school seniors and current college students starting January 1, 2026. Approximately \$290,000 in scholarships will be awarded, ranging from \$600 to \$2,500 each for the 2026-27 academic year. Every student who graduated from or will graduate this year from a North Dakota high school or home education program can apply, even if their high school doesn't have a local chapter.

Students from a wide range of backgrounds are encouraged to apply. Scholarship offerings cover a variety of categories including vocational and technical schools, military family, community service and continuing college students. Schools with local chapters also offer scholarships for their specific schools. The application deadline for all North Dakota Dollars for Scholars scholarships is April 1, 2026. Scholarship details and the online application are available at northdakota.dollarsforscholars.org. To apply,

students must establish a login and create or update a student profile This profile allows students to be matched to scholarships based on their personal information. Students will also be able to use this profile to find future opportunities from their local chapter, if the high school they graduated from has one, North Dakota Dollars for Scholars, and the national organization. The Project includes the following Work:
Contract No. 1 - Base Bid: Work generally consists of bonding, mobilization, surfacing removal, base re-compaction, and surfacing replacement of the corridors of Main Street, Central Ave, and 6th St NW. The improvements include erosion control, traffic control, removal of 27,733 SY of bituminous pavement, removal of 30,856 SF of millings, removal of 4,909 SF of concrete driveways, removal of 6,924 LF of curb & gutter, removal of 1,946 SF of valley gutter, removal of 9,061 SF of sidewalk, removal of 7,843 concrete pavement, removal of 3,878 concrete base (5"depth), installation of 26,809 SY of bituminous paving (7" depth), installation of 29,055 SY of aggregate base (12" depth), 29,055 of 12" subgrade preparation, installation of 7,196 SF of concrete driveways, installation of 7,352 LF of curb & gutter, installation of 5,047 SF of valley gutters, installation of 1,465 SY of concrete sidewalks, adjusting manholes, gate valve boxes, inlets, and curb stops, installation of 2 curb inlets and 2 60" manholes, crosswalk restriping, and seeding and maintenance.

Contract No. 1 - Alternate No. 1 - 2nd Ave NE Storm Sewer: Work generally consists of removing existing storm sewer system and installing a new system on 2nd Ave NE. These improvements include removing 2 curb inlets and storm sewer pipe, removing 308 SY of asphalt paving, installation of a catch basin, installation of 4 curb inlets, 2 inlets specials, 2 72" manholes, installation of 55 LF of 30" RCP pipe, installation of boring 36" steel pipe for 241 LF, installation of a 36" RCP FES, installation of 41 CY of NDDOT Grade I riprap, installation of 4,156 SF concrete flume, installation of 308 SY of bituminous paving, concrete replacement, backfilling, restriping, and topsoiling.

Contract No. 1 - Alternate No. 2 - 2nd Ave NE Repaving: Work generally consists of 2" mill and overlay and chip sealing of the roadway on 2nd Ave NE and restriping and reconstructing the intersection of 2nd Ave NE and 1st St NE.

Contract No. 1 - Alternate No. 3 - Valley Gutter & Chip Sealing: Work generally consists of chip sealing of the asphalt pavement in the Base Bid as well as 1st St NE and 5th Ave SE and the installation of a new valley gutter on 2nd St SE and 6th Ave SE.
