Each bid must be accompanied by a bidder's bond in a sum equal to 5% of the full amount of the bid executed by the bidder as principal and by a surety, conditioned that if the principal's bid is accepted and a contract is awarded to the principal, the principal, within ten (10) days after the notice of the award, shall execute a contract in accordance with the terms of the bid and the bid

bond, and any conditions of the City of Cando, as required by law. A countersignature of a bid bond is not required. If the City of Cando elects to award a contract to the lowest responsible bidder, and the lowest responsible bidder does not execute a contract within ten (10) days, the bidder's bond will be forfeited to the City of Cando, and the City of Cando may award the project to the next lowest responsible bidder.

Each bidder must possess a valid North Dakota contractor's license for the full amount of their bid, as required by N.D.C.C. § 43-07-7. Each bidder MUST enclose a copy of their Contractor's License or Certificate of Renewal, issued by the North Dakota Secretary of State, and each license must be valid and dated at least 10 days prior to the date set for bid opening, as required under N.D.C.C. § 43-07-12.

No bid may be read or considered if the bid does not fully comply with the requirements of this section and that any deficient bid submitted must be resealed and returned to the bidder immediately.

City of Cando reserves the right to reject any and all bids and rebid the project until a satisfactory bid is received.

State Revolving Fund Requirements
This project anticipates funding from the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund program. Bidder's attention is called to the SRF requirements in the bid package.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with American Iron and Steel requirements of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2014. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this regulation are explained in the specifications.

Bidders are required to comply with Davis-Bacon prevailing wage requirements.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the Title 40 CFR Part 33-Participation by Disadvantaged Business Enterprises in the United States Environmental Protection Agency Programs. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this regulation concern utilization of Minority Business Enterprises (MBE), Women's Business Enterprises (WBE), and Small Business Enterprises (SBE) and are explained in the specifications.

2026 North Dakota State Spelling Bee competition

The 2026 North Dakota State Spelling Bee will take place on Monday, March 23, 2026, at the Bismarck Event Center, located at 315 S. 5th Street in Bismarck.

This year's event is primarily sponsored by the North Dakota Newspaper Association Education Foundation. Additional sponsors include:

The program administrator and host of the event is the North Dakota Association of County Superintendents (NDACS), the official regional partner of the Scripps National Spelling Bee.

Ninety-nine students from across North Dakota, representing 51 of the state's 53 counties, will compete in this one-day event. Including spellers, family members, volunteers, teachers, school administrators, and spectators, more than 250 people are expected to attend.

The competition will begin in the morning with a written test consisting of 50 spelling words and 20 vocabulary questions. Once the tests are scored, the top 25 spellers, along

with any additional students tied for 25th place, will advance to the afternoon's oral spell-down. The oral competition will continue until a state champion is crowned.

The North Dakota State Spelling Bee champion will receive an expense-paid trip to Washington, D.C., to participate in "Bee Week" and compete in the 2026 Scripps National Spelling Bee during the week of Memorial Day. The grand prize includes airfare, hotel accommodations, and travel expenses for the champion and a chaperone.

Prizes will be awarded to the first, second, third, and fourth place finishers. In addition to the trip to Washington, D.C., the Scripps National Spelling Bee provides the champion with a one-year subscription to Merriam-Webster Unabridged Online, News-O-Matic, and Britannica Online Premium.
